- a) Tree maintenance update

 - The Parish Council owned lamppost in the Village Hall parking area will cost approx. £1200 to replace.
 - Proposal to remove this lamppost as it takes up much needed parking space and replace with a wall mounted light on the side of the building.
 - It was further proposed that the Village Hall will take control of the car parking lighting arrangements in future.
